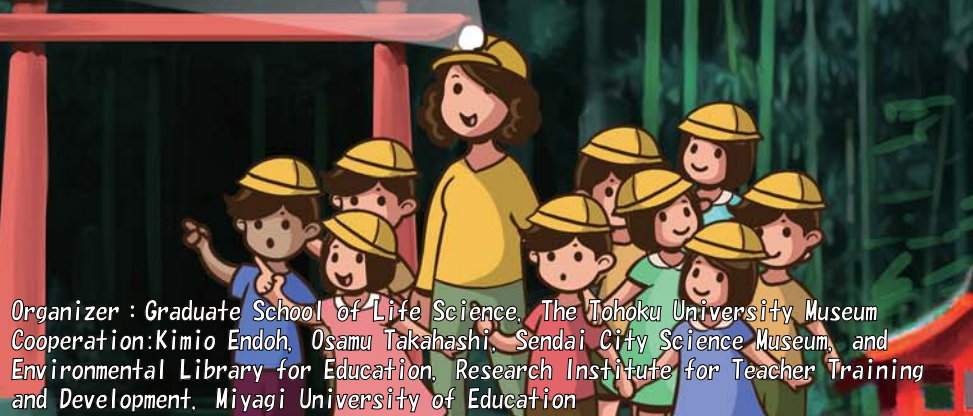
Tohoku University's ID holders are admitted free. DOKODEMO passport holders (elementary & junior high school students who live in Sendai City) are admitted free.
