Registration, confirmation, and correction period

April 8 (Tue) – April 21 (Mon), 2025

Courses to register

Please register for **Core subjects A · B · C, Specialized subjects and Related subjects (First semester / Year-round subjects)** provided by the Graduate School of Life Sciences.

*You do not need to register for "Seminars" and "Research Project A". The Academic Affairs Section will register these for all students at once.

Registration Method

Please follow the instructions in the manual to register from the "Student Affairs Information System".

- The following three courses are courses for which students can earn credits by attending joint lectures and submitting reports (Japanese only).

「Advanced Biochemistry I~II (2 credits each)」 ... Joint Lectures on Biochemistry

「Advanced Cell Biology I~II (2 credits each)」 ... Joint Lecture on Cell Biology

「Advanced Ecology I~II (2 credits each)」 ... Joint Lectures on Ecology

- These courses are year-long course. **Please register all the credits you wish to earn during the 2025 academic year during this registration period. *You cannot register for these courses during the second semester registration period in October.**

(Example) Student wants to take 4 credits of Biochemistry Joint Lectures in 2025.

(In case of attending 10 lectures and submitting 2 reports) ⇒ Register for both Advanced Biochemistry I and Advanced Biochemistry II.

- Please use the "Joint Lecture Attendance Sheet" to keep a record of which lecture you have attended and the date of your attendance.

Other

Credit-granted Seminars

If you participate in a seminar or other event recognized by the Graduate School as a "Credit-granted Seminar" and earn a certain number of points, it may be approved as a related subject.

The points should be recorded on the "Seminar Attendance Card" distributed with the orientation materials.

After earning enough points, you can receive credit by submitting your attendance card by the designated date.

In this case, registration through the system is not required.

Information about credit-granted seminars will be announced via email.

Course Registration for Courses Designated by the Division for Interdisciplinary Advanced Research and Education (DIARE) (Only for M1)

If you wish to take courses designated by the DIARE, please submit the “第1学期学際高等研究教育院 履修科目届 (Notification of Courses designated by the DIARE to be taken in the First Semester)” (distributed with the orientation materials) through the GSLS Course Registration Form.

Courses designated by the DIARE are recognized as related subjects of the Graduate School. In this case, you do not need to submit the application for related subjects (関連科目履修願) described in "Course Registration for Courses Offered by Other Graduate Schools" below.

At this time, you can only register for courses offered in the first semester and year-round courses. Registration for second semester courses will be announced again at the time of registration for second semester courses (in October).

Course Registration for Courses Offered by Other Graduate Schools

Deadline for submitting the "Application for Related Courses": April 21 (Mon)

* The original signed by the academic advisor must be submitted.

Course Registration for University-wide Education Courses (including courses related to teacher licensure)

In this case, course registration is not available through the Student Affairs Information System.

Please first obtain permission from the faculty member in charge of the course, and then submit the course registration form and a copy of the faculty member's permission email via the GSLS Course Registration Form.
